Highway Report- Ralph Warren

- The ne septic system for the highway barn is being redesigned with a 500-gallon pump tank and raised bed, due to location limitations. The propane tank will need to be moved for installation.
- All the stone, sand and salt has been hauled in for the 2024 year.
- Salt Barn the grant will cover 50% of the construction cost. Yates County Soil and Water will get the money, and then will reimburse the Town for expenses. Bids are expected for be available in the Spring of 2024

Supervisor Report— George Lawson

• Bookkeeping – George has talked with the Village of Dundee who is willing to work together as part of a shared service for the Towns bookkeeping needs. Williamson Law is the software that the Village uses, and the hope is to utilize the Village Software to minimize overhead cost, while adding an additional user, and sharing staff.

PILOT for Commercial Solar Farm

 New Leaf Energy has written requesting information on if the Town of Starkey will require a contract for a PILOT (payment in lieu of taxes) for the 3 projects that are currently under review with the Planning Board. Following discussions, John Socha, councilperson, expressed concern that there should be restrictions on locations and sizes of solar farms, he stresses that a moratorium would allow for review of zoning, to prevent a "solar mess." He goes on to state that he does not believe that the "future is not solar."

• Tony states that the Bonding has been a concern, adding that the bond needs to stay with the property to ensure the cleanup at the end of the solar project life cycle. George also stressed that it is important to work with an Attorney have has experience with projects of this nature.
